LAB # 8: Episodes 77-79

Scripture Reading: [Ep. 77] Genesis 1:28-29, Genesis 2, Genesis 12:1-3, Revelation 12:10. [Ep. 78] Matthew 18:18, Matthew 28:18. [Ep. 79] Romans 11:29.

Praying in your heavenly language (also known as praying in other tongues, praying in the spirit) is something that is important to the life of the believer, and it is a tool that is designed by God to help build-up, encourage, and provide clarity to the believer. It should be a part of your regular prayer life. Praying in the spirit allows you to bypass your thoughts and feelings to communicate directly with God from your reborn spirit. Your heavenly language cannot be decoded or infiltrated by the adversary. This makes praying in the spirit a wonderful way to get plans and strategy you need from the Holy Spirit. Becoming comfortable and fluent in praying in your heavenly language takes time and diligent effort. This is normal. Additionally, with praying in the spirit it is also necessary to request the interpretation (understanding) of what you have prayed and actively believe that the Lord will provide it to you.

Prayer Time: Practice praying in the spirit for 20 minutes daily. (This should be time that is set aside in your day and not combined with other activities.) Before you pray, thank the Lord for the day and ask Him to provide you with interpretation of what you are praying. (We are taught in Mark 11:24 that once we ask/pray in faith, we are to have confidence that God has granted our request. It is done.) The Holy Spirit will bring understanding of what you have been praying about in a variety of ways. It can be immediate understanding or come as you go about doing another task during the day; but, He will get the information to you.

Prayer Points/Focused Action:

- Continue working on walking with the Lord in absolute obedience to His guidance, daily. This must become a habit instead of an occasional occurrence. We are starting with the small things and will grow from here!
- Also, continue to use your Life-Span confession that we created in Lab #7 daily. If you have spoken negative words concerning your life for any length of time it will take time, consistency, and diligence to renew your mind completely (into the deep subconscious parts of your mind), and to release a sufficient amount of faith-filled, life-giving words into the spiritual realm concerning you. We have already taken the time to cancel those negative words, however, now they must be overturned and replaced by life giving words.

Meditation#1: Read the scriptures below to help you meditate throughout your week. This will help you better understand the importance of your words and the impact they have on your life.

Key Terms:

Enforce- To occupy the place of spiritual authority that has been given/assigned to you by the Messiah. By the power of the name of Jesus, demand satan and demonic forces comply with the divine order, rules, and laws that the Father has set forth by verbalizing limitations and demanding the devil leave/stop behaviors. [To subdue and bring demonic forces under authority, rulership of Christ. To restrain; to make subject/subservient. To make obedient.]

Instruct- Provide instructions for appropriate behavior and empower the one who is being instructed with power, ability, skill, and needed resources to complete those instructions.

Command- To order something or someone to do something or not to do something. This order is not optional as to whether it should be followed or not. There is penalty for not obeying a command. Demand.

Authority- The legal right (power) to rule or have rulership in any area, territory, or realm. The right to subdue those whom you have legal right to rule or have rulership over. God-given. The power to choose/make decisions. The legal right to bind or imprison, (enforce obedience). The right to command/demand.

Dominion (to have) –The use the legal right of rulership that has been given to you. The action of exercising authority sovereignty, or governmental control. To use the legal right to demand.

Territory - The area (natural land, realm, property, personal relationships) that one has the legal right to exercise authority and/or dominion over.

Delegate (to)- To entrust someone else with the use of your name and power to conduct tasks on your behalf. To pass responsibility and authority to conduct tasks on behalf of the one who delegates. To give power of attorney.

The Blessing- The Kingdom's (of God) way of doing and being, thinking, acting, operating, and functioning. This includes the rights of dominion and rule of authority bestowed by God through faith in Christ Jesus. It is divine empowerment to carry that out and prosper in the thing/area to which God has assigned you. The absolute favor of God resting upon and working to help you by which you can excel, be elevated, and advance.

Kingdom of God- The divine order, rules, structure, manner of operation, governmental system, and laws that the Father has set as the way He wants things to be conducted. It includes the sovereignty of God. It is the provision and care set forth by the Heavenly Father for His people. The Kingdom includes the fullness of the Godhead Himself, His created beings that have remained in their heavenly abode that He set for them, and those whose names are written in the Lamb's Book of Life. (Salvation.)

Key Take-A-Ways

1. God expects the believer to enforce the victory that Christ has already won and to enforce The Blessing in their life and in territory that is assigned to them by the Lord.
2. God gave mankind authority over the earth and over the territory that He assigned to them.
3. God is not a usurper. (He is a winner!)
4. God needs your permission to use His power on your behalf because He gave you authority and told you to have dominion.
5. If you will not drive the devil out of your life and territory, Neither will He. He will not violate His word.
